On January 29, 2013, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to grant Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri more time to comply with a provision of a stipulation and agreement that the Commission approved as part of Ameren Missouri's recently concluded rate case, ER-2012-0166. A provision of that stipulation and agreement requires Ameren Missouri to file a combined rate schedule tariff no later than January 31, 2013. Staff filed that motion in ER-2012-0166, but as that case is currently under appeal, the Commission will move Staff's motion into a new case file. In that way, the Commission will avoid confusing the record on appeal by issuing a substantive order in a case that is under appeal.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Data Center shall remove Staff's Motion to Extend Date By Which Ameren Missouri is Required to File a New Electric Rate Schedule Combining its Two Tariff Schedules Into One Tariff Schedule and Request for Expedited Treatment from File Number ER-2012-0166 and place it in File Number EO-2013-0375. 2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
