ORDER SHORTENING TIME TO RESPOND

On May 20, 2019, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a request that the Transcript from the Evidentiary Hearing in case WO-2019-0373¹ be included in the record as an Exhibit in the present case. The Office of the Public Counsel did not specify what statements or concepts were needed. On May 21, Missouri-American Water Company filed their objection. Missouri-American posited that if the Commission allows the Evidentiary Hearing Transcript of WO-2018-0373 into the record in the present case, it should also include the pre-filed Direct Testimony in WO-2018-0373.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) states that parties have ten days to respond to pleadings unless otherwise ordered. Ten days after Public Counsel's filing would be May 30, which is one day after the scheduled Commission Agenda meeting to discuss this case. Therefore, the Commission will shorten the response timeline to May 23.

¹ File Number WO-2018-0373 is currently on appeal in the Court of Appeals, and involves the same company and same issue.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. By 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 22, 2019, the Office of Public Counsel shall file a statement, with specificity, as to the facts or issue and which page and line numbers of testimony are needed from WO-2018-0373 that were not in the record of the current case, WO-2019-0184.

2. By 11 a.m., Thursday, May 23, 2019, any other party that wishes to respond on the matter of inclusion or exclusion of any part of the record in WO-2018-0373, shall file a response, with specificity, as to what portion of the record should be included or excluded from the current case, WO-2019-0184.

3. This order shall become effective when issued.
