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Complainant's Motion to Strike Respondent's Answer

Pursuant to Rule 12 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and in accordance with MO Title XXXV Chapter 509.320, The Complainant respectfully moves this court for an order striking line item No.4 from the document titled "Answer to Complaint" in this docket File No. GC-2024-0172 filed on 12/19/2023 and submitted by the respondent.

Rule 12 (f) (2) states "The court may strike from a pleading an insufficient 15 defense or any redundant, immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matter." "on motion 16 made by a party either before responding to the pleading or, if a response is not 17 allowed, within 21 days after being served with the pleading." 18

MO Title XXXV Chapter 509.320 states "a party may move to strike any redundant, immaterial, impertinent, or scandalous matter from any pleading."

The referenced Line item No.4 identifies a "delivery charge for gas used" and 22 further states it is "in accordance with its tariffs, specifically sheet No.2, 23 approved by the Missouri Public Service Commission." Therefore the line item in question is immaterial, impertinent, and 26 scandalous. 27
