**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT  
TARIFF AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Effective Date: June 15, 2019

On May 30, 2019, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed a Motion to Correct Tariff and Request for Expedited Treatment ("motion").<sup>1</sup> Contemporaneously therewith, GMO filed Tariff No. YE-2019-0215, which bears an effective date of June 29.

In the motion, GMO states that the newly filed tariff, Tariff No. YE-2019-0215, reinstates the tariff that went into effect on February 1, 2019. That tariff was superseded by Tariff No. YE-2019-0105, which inadvertently went into effect by operation of law on April 1, 2019. Approval of Tariff No. YE-2019-0215 will restore the tariff that both GMO and the Commission intended to be in effect.<sup>2</sup>

<sup>2</sup> The Commission issued an Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement on February 27, which rejected Tariff Nos. YE-2019-0103 and JE-2019-0104. That order inadvertently failed to also reject Tariff No. YE-2019-0105.

The Commission issued notice of the motion on May 30, giving parties until June 3 to respond. The Commission received no objections.

Based upon the Commission's review of the pleadings and the tariff, the Commission finds that it should grant GMO's motion. The Commission further finds good cause to grant expedited treatment of the tariff due to GMO's intent and the Commission's intent that Tariff No. YE-2019-0215 be effective earlier.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Motion to Correct Tariff and Request for Expedited Treatment are granted.
2. The following tariff sheet in Tariff No. YE-2019-0215, issued May 30, 2019, is hereby approved to become effective on June 15, 2019:
