ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On May 21, 2019, the Eastern Missouri Laborers District Council (EMLDC) and its affiliated local unions in Missouri, filed an application to intervene out of time in this matter. The EMLDC is an affiliate council of the Laborers International Union of North America whose members are construction workers, government workers, health care providers, industrial employees, service workers, and educators residing and working in Missouri, including within the areas affected by Ameren Missouri's resource planning in this proceeding.

More than ten days have passed since that application to intervene was filed and no one has responded to the application. The Commission finds that allowing the EMLDC to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene of the Eastern Missouri Laborers District Council is granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
