ORDER GRANTING WAIVER

On May 20, 2019, Spire Missouri Inc. (“Spire”) filed pleadings requesting a waiver of the Commission’s 60-day notice of intended case filings rule.¹ Spire states that the Commission has good cause to waive that rule because Spire has not communicated with the Commission within the prior 150 days about this Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge request.

The Commission directed that any responses to the requests be filed no later than May 30, 2019. No responses were filed.

The pertinent rule states that a party can request a waiver of the Commission’s 60-day rule for good cause. Good cause for waiver “may include, among other things, a verified declaration from the filing party that it has had no communication with the office of the commission within the prior one hundred fifty (150) days regarding any substantive issue likely to be in the case.”²

Spire filed a verified declaration from the filing party that it has had no communication with the office of the commission within the prior one hundred fifty (150) days regarding any substantive issue likely to be in the case. Thus, Spire's request complies with the Commission's rule. The Commission finds good cause exists to grant Spire the requested waiver.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The requests of Spire Missouri Inc., for waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-4.017(1) in this file are granted.
2. This order shall be effective on June 11, 2019.


