**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CORRECT
TARIFF AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Issue Date: June 24, 2019

Effective Date: July 4, 2019

On June 14, 2019, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") filed a Motion to Correct Tariff and Request for Expedited Treatment ("motion").¹ Contemporaneously therewith, GMO filed Tariff Nos. YE-2019-0221 and YE-2019-0222, which bear an effective date of July 14.²

In the motion, GMO states that the tariffs are meant to implement the Commission's Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement. Tariff No. YE-2019-0105 inadvertently went into effect by operation of law on April 1, 2019, thereby canceling the intended tariff.

² GMO filed this motion in File No. EO-2019-0132 instead of EO-2019-0133 because the Commission consolidated these cases on December 27, 2018.

Approval of Tariff Nos. YE-2019-0221 and YE-2019-0222 will restore the tariff that both GMO and the Commission intended to be in effect.³

The Commission issued notice of the motion on June 14, giving parties until June 19 to respond. The Commission received no objections.

Based upon the Commission's review of the pleadings and the tariff, the Commission finds that it should grant GMO's motion. The Commission further finds good cause to grant expedited treatment of the tariff due to GMO's intent and the Commission's intent that Tariff Nos. YE-2019-0221 and YE-2019-0222 be effective.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion to Correct Tariff and Request for Expedited Treatment are granted.
2. Tariff Nos. YE-2019-0221 and YE-2019-0222, issued June 14, 2019, are hereby approved to become effective on July 4, 2019.
3. This order shall be effective July 4, 2019.
