### ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR FILING RESPONSES

Issue Date: June 27, 2019 Effective Date: June 27, 2019

The Commission opened this file as a working case to facilitate Staff's investigation of the self-commit and self-scheduling practices of Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities in their respective RTO energy markets. The Commission's order opening this file directed the investor-owned electric utilities to provide certain generation and self-commitment data to the Commission's Staff by June 28, 2019. The Commission allowed for further submissions and responses to be made by any stakeholder by July 8.

On June 27, Staff filed a motion seeking an extension of the previously established dates for filing and responding to information. The Commission will do so.

#### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, Kansas City Power & Light Company, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, and The Empire District Electric Company shall provide the generation and self-commitment data they were previously ordered to provide by July 8, 2019, rather than June 28, 2019.
- 2. Any other stakeholder may provide information for consideration by July 8, 2019, rather than June 28, 2019.

- 3. Any stakeholder may review the submissions and may respond to those submissions, or provide additional related materials by July 17, 2019, rather than July 8, 2019.
- 4. Staff shall file a report regarding its investigation by August 23, 2019, rather than August 16, 2019.
- 5. Stakeholders may respond to the Staff report by September 6, 2019, rather than August 30, 2019.
  - 6. This order shall be effective when issued.
