ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF INTERVENTION REQUESTS

On June 28, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities Company (Liberty-Empire) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") its 2019 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. The purpose of the IRP is to ensure that investor-owned electric utilities, such as Liberty-Empire, consider all options, including demand-side efficiency and energy management measures, so as to provide safe, reliable and efficient electric service to the public at reasonable rates, in a manner that serves the public interest.

As required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(6), the Commission will give notice of Liberty-Empire's filing to potentially interested parties and will set a date for the filing of requests to intervene.¹

¹ This file was initially opened on September 20, 2018, when Liberty-Empire filed an application for variances related to preparation of its IRP filing. On October 22, 2018, the Commission granted the applications to intervene filed by the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy and Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri. Those entities remain parties to this case and do not need to reapply for intervention.

- 1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Liberty-Empire's Missouri service area and to the members of the General Assembly representing that service area.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall deliver a copy of this order to all parties to Liberty-Empire's most recent general rate proceeding, File No. ER-2016-0023, and its most recent integrated resource plan triennial filing, File No. EO-2016-0223.
- 2. Any proper person wishing to intervene in this matter shall file an application to do so no later than July 26, 2019. Such applications shall be filed with:
