ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE AND EXTENDING THE TIME TO ISSUE A RECOMMENDED REPORT AND ORDER

Issue Date: January 2, 2024 Effective Date: January 2, 2024

On September 28, 2023,¹ Complainants Dranel J. Clark and Aquilla Canada filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. Based on the amount in dispute alleged by Complainants, the Commission gave notice on September 28 that the matter would proceed under the Commission's Small Formal Complaint Case procedure.² Also on September 28, the Commission directed its Staff to investigate Complainants' complaint and file a report no later than November 13.

On October 27, Ameren Missouri filed a *Request for Mediation*, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.125(2). On October 25, Complainants sent an e-mail to all other parties which indicated that they did not wish to participate in mediation.

On November 9, Staff requested additional time in which to file its investigative report, and, on November 13, the Commission granted the request, giving Staff until December 20 to file its report.

On November 21, Ameren Missouri filed its *Answer and Affirmative Defenses*. On December 20, Staff filed its *Staff Report*. Having received Complainants' complaint, Ameren Missouri's answer, and Staff's investigative report, this matter is ready to proceed. In order to discuss a procedural schedule, the Commission will set a procedural conference. The procedural conference will be conducted via WebEx video and teleconference for the convenience of the parties.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(G) states that after affording the parties reasonable opportunity for discovery and a fair hearing, the regulatory law judge in a small formal complaint case shall issue a recommended report and order within 100 days following the filing of the complaint. However, the time period may be extended upon a finding of good cause by the regulatory law judge. The 100-day period in this case expires on January 6, 2024.

Given Staff's request for additional time in which to complete its investigation, good cause exists to extend the time period allowed to resolve this matter. Therefore, the time period under the Commission rule to issue a recommended report and order will be extended.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties shall appear by video or phone at a procedural conference to be held on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>January 17</u>, <u>2024</u>, at <u>10:00 a.m.</u> To participate in the procedural conference by phone, at the time of the conference, call 1-312-535-8110, follow the

prompts, and enter meeting number 2633 708 8232, followed by # (pound/hashtag symbol). If prompted for a password, enter 0111. To participate via video, go to the WebEx website (www.webex.com) or download the application to join the meeting using meeting number 2633 708 8232 and password 0111. If you need additional accommodations in accordance with the American with Disabilities Act to participate in this conference, please call the Public Service Commission's Hotline at 1-800-392-4211 (voice) or Relay Missouri at 711 before the conference. Failure to appear at the conference without being excused may result in dismissal of the complaint in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(5).

- 2. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070(15)(G), issuance of a recommended report and order in this matter is extended for good cause beyond one hundred (100) days following the filing of the complaint.
 - 3. This order is effective when issued.
