b. The amount of the advance payment is credited to the customer's account as applying to any indebtedness under the contract.

8. Payment of Service - The customer is required to pay all charges for service in accordance with the Telephone Company's regular billing and collection practices.

9. Deposits - The Telephone Company may, in order to safeguard its interest, require an applicant or a customer to make a suitable deposit to be held by the Telephone Company as a guarantee of the payment of charges. The fact that a deposit has been made in no way relieves the applicant or customer from complying with the Telephone Company's regulations as to advance payment and the prompt payment of bills on presentation. At such time as the contract is terminated, the amount of the deposit is credited to the customer's account and any credit balance which may remain is refunded. At the option of the Telephone Company, such a deposit may be refunded or credited to the customer at any time prior to termination of the contract. In case of a cash deposit, simple interest at the legal rate is paid for the period during which the deposit is held by the Telephone Company, provided the period is sixty days or more.

10. Cancellation for Cause - Upon nonpayment of any sum due the Telephone Company or upon a violation of any of the conditions governing the furnishing of a service or upon the use of any service for the purpose of performing any service in competition with the service which the Telephone Company or its connecting carriers may now or hereafter furnish, the Telephone Company may, by notice in writing to the customer without incurring any liability, forthwith discontinue the furnishing of said service and terminate the contract.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Authority to Establish Experimental Extended Measured Service

On March 20, 1987, the Missouri Public Service Commission ordered the company to establish Extended Measured Service (EMS) between the Company's Huntsville and Jacksonville exchanges to Southwestern Bell Telephone Company's Moberly exchange. This experimental service was initially ordered to be established as of June 18, 1987. The company was later granted an extension to August 18, 1987, in the Public Service Commission's order of Clarification and Denial of Petitions for Rehearing, issued May 14, 1987.

B. Definition of Experimental Extended Measured Service

Experimental Extended Measured Service (EMS) provides for extra-exchange calling between two exchanges where a community of interest has been demonstrated, at less than toll rates. There are two forms of EMS:

1. Extended Community Calling

Extended Community Calling (ECC) is a mandatory, two-way service established between the petitioning exchange and the requested exchange. ECC service is mandatory in that it replaces Message Toll Service between the affected exchanges. However, customers do not pay the EMS rate for this service unless they use the service. ECC measures distance, duration and time-of-day as does Message Toll Service and is priced at fifty (50) percent of the Message Toll Service rate that would apply if ECC were not offered in an exchange, applied to all time periods and mileage bands. ECC rates do not apply to operator assisted calls, excepting that ECC rates will apply to operator assisted calls placed by a visually impaired customer. ECC rates do not apply to coin telephone service. ECC rates do not apply to credit card calls.
