## COMPLAINANT'S PROPOSED SCHEDULING ORDER

For good cause, no scheduling order has previously been entered in this matter and it is not yet set for hearing. Staff has conducted its investigation which is, in the view of Coalition, incomplete. The parties have met and conferred in hopes of reaching an agreed resolution of this matter, but regrettably these endeavors have been unsuccessful. The exchange of information in the settlement negotiations, however, has been beneficial to the Coalition's understanding of the issues in this case but are not admissible in formal proceedings before the Commission.

The Coalition, therefore, respectfully suggests that the parties be allowed to propound data requests through April 1, 2024, conduct depositions through May 17, 2024, and file written testimony and deposition designations through June 28, 2024.
