**ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSES
AND SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Effective Date: January 9, 2024

On August 7, 2023, Judith Turner-Davis filed an application with the Commission requesting a change of electric supplier from Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West to Platte-Clay Electrical Cooperative.

On January 4, 2024, an evidentiary hearing was held in which oral testimony and documentary evidence was offered.

On January 8, 2024, Evergy Missouri West informed the Commission that it, Platte-Clay Electrical Cooperative, and the Staff of the Commission had received an e-mail from Ms. Turner-Davis on January 5, 2024, in which Ms. Turner-Davis stated that she is “withdrawing [her] request to change energy providers. . . .”

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116 allows an applicant to voluntarily dismiss an application. However, “[o]nce evidence has been offered . . . , an applicant . . . may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of all the parties.”

The Commission will direct Ms. Turner-Davis to file a response as to whether she wishes to dismiss her application or not. If Ms. Turner-Davis does not respond, then the

Commission may dismiss her application for good cause, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(4).

The Commission will also allow the other parties an opportunity to file any objections or other response to dismissal of the application and will suspend the deadlines remaining in the procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Judith Turner-Davis shall file a response stating whether or not she wishes to dismiss her application for a change of electric supplier no later than January 23, 2024.
2. Any other parties wishing to file a response shall do so no later than January 23, 2024.
3. All procedural schedule deadlines in this case, including the January 19, 2024, deadline for initial briefs, are suspended until further order of this Commission.
4. This order is effective when issued.
