PROTECTIVE ORDER

On June 28, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities Company (Liberty-Empire) filed its 2019 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. Along with its IRP, Liberty-Empire filed a motion for protective order seeking additional protection for certain commercially sensitive information that has been filed, or will otherwise be disclosed, in this case. Liberty-Empire seeks leave to designate that information as Highly Confidential as permitted by the Commission's confidential information rule, 4 CSR 240-2.135(4).

More than ten days have passed since Liberty-Empire filed its motion and no party has responded. The Commission will issue the requested protective order. The specific extra protections to be afforded to the information designated by Liberty-Empire as highly confidential are described in this order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Certain materials and information divulged by Liberty-Empire shall be considered to be "Highly Confidential" if so designated at the time of disclosure.
- 2. With regard to entities and individuals other than the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, and the Missouri Division of Energy:

a. Disclosure of materials or information so designated shall be made only to attorneys of record or to such outside consultants who have executed a Commission Nondisclosure Agreement. No Highly Confidential information shall be provided directly or indirectly to any non-attorney individual or employee.

b. Persons afforded access to materials or information designated Highly Confidential shall neither use nor disclose such materials or information for purposes of business or competition or any other purpose other than in regard to this case, and shall keep the materials and information secure and confidential and in accordance with the purposes and intent of this protective order.

c. All material and information designated as Highly Confidential in the possession of any entity or person, as well as any notes pertaining to such information, shall be returned to Liberty-Empire or destroyed upon the conclusion of this case.

- 3. If a party disagrees with the Highly Confidential designation of any information, the party shall follow the informal discovery dispute resolution procedures set forth in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090(8). If the party exhausts those dispute resolution procedures, the party may file a motion challenging the designation.
 - 4. This order shall be effective when issued.
