ORDER SCHEDULING A PROCEDURAL CONFERENCE

On April 19, 2019, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application asking the Commission to cancel the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted to Ameren Missouri in 2005 applicable to the property formerly occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Noranda and now occupied by the aluminum smelter owned by Magnitude 7 Metals, LLC. Ameren Missouri also asked the Commission to cancel its Large Transmission Service (LTS) rate schedule under which Noranda was the only qualifying customer. The Commission's Staff has filed a recommendation advising the Commission to approve the Application. Public Counsel, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group oppose the application and ask the Commission to schedule a hearing.

The Commission will schedule a conference to discuss the establishment of a procedural schedule to consider Ameren Missouri's Application.
