**ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO SET ASIDE ORDER OF  
DEFAULT AND DISMISSING COMPLAINT**

Issue Date: July 10, 2019

Effective Date: August 9, 2019

On March 21, 2019, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) filed a Complaint against Netwolves Network Services, LLC (“Company” or “Respondent”). The Complaint was based on Staff’s assertion that the Company failed to timely file its 2017 Annual Report as required by Section 392.210(1), RSMO, and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-28.012 (1)(A) and (C). On May 28, 2019, Staff filed a Motion for Default Judgment and for Authority to Seek Penalties based on the fact that the Company had not filed a response to the Complaint. On June 12, 2019, the Commission issued its Order Granting Staff’s Motion for Default Judgment and Authority to Seek Penalties (“Default Order”) with an effective date of July 12, 2019.

On June 28, 2019, Staff filed a Motion to Set Aside Order of Default and Dismiss ("Motion"). Staff's Motion states that the Respondent filed its 2017 Annual Report with the Commission on June 14, 2019, asks the Commission to set aside its Default Order, and asks the Commission to dismiss Staff's Complaint.

By filing its 2017 Annual Report, the Company remedied the delinquency alleged in Staff's Complaint, and there is no longer a need to pursue the Complaint, a default judgment, or penalties in this matter. Therefore, since the violation has been corrected, the Commission will grant Staff's Motion, set aside the Default Order, and dismiss Staff's Complaint.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Staff's Motion to Set Aside Default Judgment and Authority to Seek Penalties is granted.
2. Staff's Complaint is dismissed without prejudice.
3. This Order shall be effective on August 9, 2019.
4. This file shall be closed on August 10, 2019.
