ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On June 28, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities Company (Liberty-Empire) filed its 2019 Integrated Resource Plan, which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 4 CSR 240-22. In response to that filing, the Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and ordered that any party wishing to intervene file an application to do so by July 26. The Missouri Joint Municipal Electrical Utility Commission (MJMEUC) and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) applied to intervene on July 3, 2019. More than ten days have passed since those applications to intervene were filed and no one has responded to either application.

After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing MJMEUC and MECG to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of the Missouri Joint Municipal Electrical Utility Commission is granted.

2. The Application to Intervene of the Midwest Energy Consumers Group is granted.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
