### ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME

On February 12, 2019, Elm Hills Utility Operating Company, Inc. ("Elm Hills"), filed an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity with the Public Service Commission ("Commission"). The Commission ordered the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") to file a recommendation no later than April 15, which was extended to May 20, further extended to June 20, and subsequently extended to July 22. All prior motions for extension were jointly filed by all parties.

On July 18, Staff filed a *Motion for Further Extension of Time to File Staff's Recommendation*. Staff cites the need for further discussions between the City of Sedalia and Elm Hills regarding the effect, if any, of part of Elm Hills' subject service area being within the City of Sedalia's corporate limits.

Staff asserts in its *Motion* that Elm Hills does not oppose this motion, and the City of Sedalia is in support of this motion. The Office of the Public Counsel has filed a statement that it does not oppose the *Motion*.

The Commission finds that the joint request for further extension is reasonable and will grant it.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion for Further Extension of Time to File Staff's Recommendation filed by Staff on July 18, 2019, is granted.
  - 2. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than October 21, 2019.
  - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
