## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO INTERVENE

On June 28, 2019, The Empire District Electric Company, a Liberty Utilities Company filed its 2019 Integrated Resource Plan, which is required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 4 CSR 240-22. In response to that filing, the Commission provided notice of the filing to potentially interested parties and ordered that any party wishing to intervene file an application to do so by July 26. Dogwood Energy, LLC applied to intervene on July 12, 2019. More than ten days have passed since that motion to intervene was filed and no one has responded.

After considering the unopposed motion to intervene, the Commission finds that allowing Dogwood to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Dogwood Energy, LLC's Motion to Intervene is granted.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.


