On July 24, 2019, Ameren Missouri filed a request to delay the start of the evidentiary hearing scheduled in this matter from July 25, 2019, until August 1, 2019. Ameren Missouri states that the parties in this case have filed both a *First Amended Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement* and a *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement as to MSBA Issues*. These two filings resolve all contested issues between the parties. While both documents are non-unanimous stipulations, the non-signatory parties to each document have affirmatively filed a pleading indicating they do not oppose the non-unanimous stipulations.

The Commission makes no determination at this time regarding the treatment of the non-unanimous stipulations. The Commission will delay the start date of the hearing to consider how to proceed.

1. The start of the evidentiary hearing scheduled to begin on July 25, 2019, is postponed until August 1, 2019, at 9:00 a.m.
