**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND  
SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE**

On July 24, 2019, Timber Creek Sewer Company filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a sewer system in the in Clay County, Missouri, as an addition to Timber Creek’s existing service territories.

The requested CCN would allow the Company to provide wastewater treatment and collection system operation and maintenance to a single residence outside the Oak Brook subdivision currently served by Timber Creek. Timber Creek states that the property owner will be responsible for building the necessary collection line to Timber Creek’s system. There will be no need to install new facilities or for construction by Timber Creek, so no financing is anticipated. Timber Creek is not aware of any franchises or permits from municipalities, counties, or other authorities that would be required.

Timber Creek proposes to provide sewer service pursuant to the existing rules and regulations currently found in Timber Creek’s tariff, P.S.C. MO NO. 2; and pursuant to the rates found on 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Sheet No. 4, of that tariff.

Timber Creek also requests a waiver of the notice requirement in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.017(1), Timber Creek states that it has had no communication with the office of the Commission within the prior 150 days regarding the subject matter of its application.

The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests. The Commission will also direct its Staff to file a recommendation on its review of Timber Creek's application.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Clay County, Missouri, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Clay County, Missouri, and to the media serving Clay County, Missouri.
3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than August 24, 2019. Such application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing Information System.
4. The Commission's Staff shall file either a status report or a recommendation on Timber Creek's application no later than September 6, 2019.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.

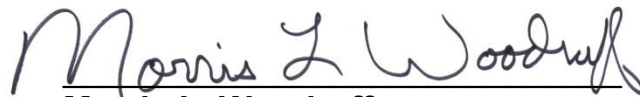
