# ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT AND ESTABLISHING TIME FOR FILING OF RECOMMENDATIONS

On September 27, 2000, Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) filed an Application to Renew Price Stabilization Fund on Either a Modified or Unchanged Basis. MGE's Application included a motion requesting that the Commission approve the application as expeditiously as possible and no later than October 26, 2000.

October 26, the Commission will need to have a recommendation from its Staff by October 18. On October 2, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to Respond to Motion for Expedited Consideration. That order directed Staff to file, by October 5, a statement indicating whether or not it would be able to file its recommendation by October 18. On October 3, Staff filed a Notice indicating that it will file its recommendation not later than October 18.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Missouri Gas Energy's Motion for Expedited Treatment is granted.
- 2. That no later than October 18, 2000, the Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a Staff recommendation regarding Missouri Gas

Energy's Application to Renew Price Stabilization Fund on Either a Modified or Unchanged Basis.

- 3. That any other party that wishes to file a recommendation regarding Missouri Gas Energy's Application to Renew Price Stabilization Fund on Either a Modified or Unchanged Basis shall do so not later than October 18, 2000.
- 4. That any party that wishes to file a response to the recommendation of Staff or to the recommendation of any other party shall do so not more than three days after the filing of the recommendation.
  - 5. That this order shall become effective on October 14, 2000.
