MOTION TO OPEN A CASE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) by and through its attorney, and in support of its request to open a case, states as follows:

- 1. Under Section 393.140 RSMo 1994, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) has authority to establish a case in order to receive information from public utilities under its jurisdiction. Missouri Gas Energy (MGE), a division of Southern Union Company, is a "gas corporation" as defined in Section 386.020(18) (Cum. Supp. 1998) and is a "public utility" subject to the Commission's jurisdiction under Section 386.020(42) (Cum. Supp. 1998).
 - 2. MGE provides natural gas service in Warrensburg, Missouri.
- 3. On Monday, July 24, 2000, at approximately 2:47 p.m., a flash fire occurred at 205 East Oak Street, Warrensburg, Missouri. As a result of the incident, the house at 205 East Oak Street sustained moderate damage. An occupant of the structure sustained second-degree burns during the fire and required hospitalization. There were no fatalities.

4. The Gas Safety Staff of the Commission has initiated a formal investigation into this matter and the request to open a case is being sought for the purpose of receiving the Gas Incident Report pertaining to the incident investigation.

5. Commission policy as enunciated in IP-2 (Missouri Public Service Commission, Internal Procedures) provides for the opening of a case for the purpose of receiving the Incident Report in connection with the incident's investigation.

THEREFORE, based upon the foregoing, the Staff respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order establishing a case for the purpose of receiving a Gas Incident Report in connection with this incident.
