ORDER ESTABLISHING CASE

On February 24, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a motion to open a case, alleging that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) has the authority to establish a case for the purpose of receiving information from a public utility under its jurisdiction pursuant to Section 393.140, RSMo 1994. Staff stated that Missouri Gas Energy (MGE) is a gas corporation as defined in Section 386.020(18), RSMo Supp. 1999, and, as such, is a public utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction under 386.020(42), RSMo Supp. 1999.

MGE provides natural gas service to a house at 205 East Oak Street, Warrensburg, Missouri, where an explosion occurred at approximately 2:47 p.m. on July 24, 2000, according to Staff. As a result of the incident, Staff stated that the house sustained moderate damage and, although there were no fatalities, an occupant of the structure sustained second-degree burns during the fire and subsequently required hospitalization. Finally, Staff stated that it has initiated a formal investigation into the incident.

Staff requested that the Commission establish a case for the purpose of receiving information, including a gas incident report, relating to the incident at 205 East Oak Street, Warrensburg, Missouri.

The Commission determines that a case should be established to receive information relevant to the above-described incident and to determine what, if any, action by the Commission is warranted. Thus, the Commission will establish case number GS-2001-216.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That case number GS-2001-216 is hereby established for the purpose of receiving a gas incident report from the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and the response of Missouri Gas Energy thereto, pertaining to the incident which occurred on July 24, 2000, at 205 East Oak Street, Warrensburg, Missouri.
- 2. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its accident report no later than February 9, 2001.
 - 3. That this order shall become effective on October 12, 2000.
