ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On June 12, 2019, the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) ordered the adoption of a procedural schedule, which included a deadline of August 5, to submit surrebuttal. On July 31, multiple parties in this case submitted a Stipulation and Agreement, purporting to resolve all issues, except those raised by Western Missouri & Kansas Laborers District Council.

As settlement discussions continue, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) has requested a delay in the date for submission of surrebuttal testimony from August 5 until August 13. Ameren Missouri, in its motion, states that counsel for Ameren Missouri has consulted with counsel for all parties and represents that none object to Ameren Missouri’s motion for delay. Based on the representation of counsel, the Commission will consider the motion to delay filing surrebuttal testimony to be unopposed.

The Commission finds that the unopposed request for extension is reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion to Delay Surrebuttal Testimony* filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri on August 2, 2019, is granted.
2. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri shall file its surrebuttal testimony no later than August 13, 2019.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
