**NOTICE INFORMING THE PARTIES OF PARTICULAR COMMISSION
QUESTIONS AT THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING**

Issue Date: August 5, 2019

After reviewing the prefiled testimony the Commission notifies the parties that they should be prepared to present testimony to respond to certain Commission questions at the evidentiary hearing. If the Commission ultimately determines an AAO or other deferral accounting mechanism should be ordered in connection with GMO's retirement of Sibley Units 1, 2, and 3, and common plant, a base line will need to be established. Accordingly, each party should be prepared to provide testimony, or otherwise address, the following:

1. Based upon the cost of service calculations from GMO's most recent rate case, what are the expected revenues from and recurring expenses to operate the Sibley facility?
2. If a party believes a different method is more appropriate to determine the baseline expected revenues from and recurring expenses to operate the Sibley

facility in GMO's current rates, what is that method and what are those amounts?

The parties should also be prepared to answer general questions related to GMO's 2016, 2017, and 2018 Annual Reports.


