ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME AND SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES

On June 25, 2019, Citizens Electric Corporation ("Citizens") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking a finding that the Commission lacks jurisdiction over the captioned matter, or alternatively for approval of a sale of certain electric transmission facilities.

Thereafter, the Commission ordered the Staff of the Commission ("Staff") to file a recommendation or a request for additional time no later than July 26. In a motion filed on July 26, Staff requests an extension of time for the completion of discovery. Citizens has not requested expedited treatment in this matter.

More than ten days have passed since Staff filed its motion, and no one has opposed that motion.¹ The Commission finds that the unopposed request for extension is reasonable and will grant it.

¹ Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(13) allows parties ten days from the filing of a pleading to respond unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion for Additional Time to File Staff Recommendation* filed by Staff on July 26, 2019, is granted.
2. Staff shall file its recommendation no later than October 15, 2019.
3. Any responses to Staff's recommendation shall be filed no later than October 25, 2019.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
