**ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF
THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

On July 24, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, filed a tariff designed to increase its annual revenues for electric service. The Commission suspended that tariff and established August 17 as the deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene.

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) applied to intervene on August 17. MDNR is a state agency responsible for planning for energy resource development, management, and conservation. More than ten days have passed since MDNR applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that the interest of MDNR in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing MDNR to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of The Missouri Department of Natural Resources is granted.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
