NOTICE OF COMPLETION AS TO TAN-TAR-A STATE ROAD, LLC

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc., (“Confluence Rivers” or “Company”) and for its *Notice of Completion as to Tan-Tar-A State Road, LLC* respectfully states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On December 8, 2022, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Acquisition of Assets and Granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”) in this case. Paragraph 3 on pages 6 and 7 of the *Order* list the conditions and requirements contained in Staff’s recommendation. Subparagraph *n)* directs the Company to “file notice in this File No. once conditions a) through m) above have been completed.”

2. Confluence Rivers hereby provides notice to the Commission that the Company has completed the following:

3. Regarding conditions *a)* and *b)*, the Commission approved the Company’s Compliance tariffs on December 16, 2022.

4. Regarding condition *c)*, the Company filed its *Notice of Closing as to Tan-Tar-A State Road, LLC* on June 20, 2023.

5. Regarding condition *f)*, the Company is keeping its financial books and records for plant-in-service and operating expenses in accordance with the NARUC Uniform System of Accounts.

6. Regarding condition *g*), the Company has adopted its current depreciation rates for Tan-Tar-A State Road, LLC (“Tan-Tar-A”).

7. Regarding condition *h*), the Company has provided training to its call center personnel regarding rates and rules applicable to the water customers in the Tan-Tar-A service area.

8. Regarding condition *i*), the Company distributed to the customers in the Tan-Tar-A service area an informational brochure detailing the rights and responsibilities of the Company and its customers.

9. Regarding condition *j*), the Company provided the Customer Experience Department (“CXD”) Staff an example of its actual communication with the Tan-Tar-A customers regarding its acquisition and operations of the water system, and how customers may reach the Company.

10. Regarding condition *k*), the Company provided CXD Staff and the Manager of the Staff Water, Sewer, and Steam Department a sample of five billing statements from the first three month’s billing for Tan-Tar-A.

11. Regarding condition *m*), the Company has included the Tan-Tar-A water customers in its established monthly reporting to the CXD Staff on customer service and billing issues on an ongoing basis.

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers respectfully submits this *Notice of Completion as to Tan-Tar-A State Road, LLC* to the Commission.
