ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE STATEMENTS OF POSITION

The procedural schedule requires the parties to file their statements of position on April 21, 2011. On April 21, Ameren Missouri, acting on behalf of all the parties, filed a motion asking for a one-day extension of time to file those statements. The motion states that the parties were unable to agree upon and file a list of issues until April 21 and need a day to prepare their statements of position regarding those issues.

The motion for additional time is reasonable and is unopposed. The Commission will grant the requested extension of time. The Commission reminds the parties that EFIS will be shut down for maintenance and thus will be unavailable from 5:30 to 9:00 p.m. on April 22.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's Motion for One-Day Extension of Time to File Statements of Position is granted and the time to file statements of position is extended to April 22, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
