ORDER SETTING A PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On November 1, 2010, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO). The Commission provided notice of the filing and has allowed four interested parties to intervene.

The Commission will schedule a prehearing conference to discuss a procedural schedule for consideration of Ameren Missouri's application.
