ORDER RESCHEDULING HEARING

Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, has applied to the Commission to extend its authority to continue the transfer of functional control of its electric transmission system to the Midwest ISO. The hearing on that application was scheduled to take place on November 21 and 22, 2011, but on November 18, the Commission granted a motion to continue that hearing. Subsequently, the Commission directed the parties to propose new dates for the hearing. The parties now propose that the hearing be rescheduled for February 9 and 10, 2012.

Those dates are acceptable and the Commission will reschedule the hearing accordingly. The Commission also notes that the parties filed statements of position before a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement was filed by some of the parties. The existence of that non-unanimous stipulation and agreement may change the position of some or all of the parties. In addition, the order of witnesses may have changed with the new hearing dates. Therefore, the Commission will direct the parties to file new statements of position and a revised order of witnesses. The Commission will establish a revised briefing schedule after the hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following revised procedural schedule is established:
