ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION

Issue Date: January 31, 2024

Effective Date: March 1, 2024

On August 7, 2023, Judith Turner-Davis filed an application with the Commission requesting a change of electric supplier from Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West to Platte-Clay Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Platte-Clay).

On January 4, 2024, an evidentiary hearing was held in which oral testimony and documentary evidence was offered.

On January 8, 2024, Evergy Missouri West informed the Commission that it, Platte-Clay, and the Staff of the Commission had received an e-mail from Ms. Turner-Davis on January 5, 2024, in which Ms. Turner-Davis stated the following:

This is to inform the Commission, Evergy Missouri West, Inc., Platte Clay Electrical Cooperative and all others involved that I am withdrawing my request to change energy providers on my property

An applicant may voluntarily dismiss an application. However, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(1) states, in part, the following:

Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of all the parties.

On January 9, 2024, the Commission directed Ms. Turner-Davis to file a response by January 23, 2024, verifying that she wished to dismiss her application. Ms. Turner-Davis did not file a response. Pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.116(4), the Commission may dismiss a case for good cause found by the Commission after a minimum of ten days notice to all parties involved.

Based on Ms. Turner-Davis's written desire to withdraw her application, the Commission finds good cause to dismiss her application.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The change of electric supplier application of Judith Turner-Davis is dismissed.
2. This order shall become effective on March 1, 2024.
3. This file shall be closed on March 2, 2024.
