ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Application to Intervene* ("motion") of Kansas Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("KEP Co-op"). KEP Co-op filed the motion on March 26, 2012. The Commission received no response within the time provided by regulation.¹ The Commission may grant the motion on allegations of:

. . . an interest which is different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case [²]

KEP Co-op alleges an ownership interest in the assets at issue, so the Commission will grant the motion.
