ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

In order to be able to take advantage of Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's solar rebate program, Thomas L. Chaney has filed an application with the Commission for a change electric supplier from Cuivre River Electric Cooperative, Inc. to Ameren Missouri. The Staff of the Commission, Cuivre River and Ameren Missouri all oppose the application.

Although the companies initially sought a determination on the pleadings, they now request an evidentiary hearing. Because the parties have filed a number of pleadings, the Commission will not require pre-filed testimony, prehearing briefs or position statements. At the close of the hearing, the Judge will discuss with the parties the necessity of filing post-hearing briefs. At present, post hearing briefs will not be required.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. An evidentiary hearing shall be held on September 10, 2012, at the Wainwright State Office Building, 111 North 7th Street, Suite 105, St. Louis, Missouri, beginning at 9:00 a.m. The hearing will be held in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
