MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT
AND EXPEDITED EFFECTIVE DATE

COMES NOW IM Telecom, LLC d/b/a Infiniti Mobile, by and through counsel, and respectfully requests the Commission to shorten the effective date in this matter, to wit:

1. On January 31, 2024, the Commission issued its *Order Granting Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier* in this matter. The Order bore a 30-day effective date of March 1, 2024.
2. Infiniti requests that the Commission amend its January 31 Order to become effective on February 10, 2024, which is ten (10) days after the Order was issued.
3. No negative effect on other entities or the public would result from hastening the effective date of Infiniti’s ETC authorization. Infiniti’s potential customers and the public would benefit from earlier availability of Infiniti’s ETC services.
4. This motion is being filed as soon as possible after realizing the lengthy delay in being able to provide the authorized ETC services due to the 30-day effective date of the Commission’s Order of January 31, 2024. In hindsight, Infiniti wishes it had filed a motion for expedited treatment with its application on December 14, 2023. Infiniti’s focus then was on the

substance of the application itself and not on the length of time it would take for an order to take effect. With ETC authorization now in hand, Infiniti is focusing on the potential customers who will benefit from the ETC services Infiniti is now authorized to offer. Infiniti is desirous of being able to offer those services as soon as possible. This would benefit those potential customers with no negative effect on others.

5. There is precedent for an ETC order to bear less than a 30-day effective date. See, for example, AmeriMex Communications d/b/a SafetyNet Wireless (RA-2020-0386). In that case, an order issued July 23, 2020 was made effective on August 2, 2020, a 10-day period.

WHEREFORE, IM Telecom, LLC d/b/a Infiniti Mobile respectfully requests the Commission to amend its *Order Granting Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier* issued in this case on January 31, 2024 to shorten the effective date of that Order to February 10, 2024.
