On February 17, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to quickly rule upon various variance requests contained within Ameren Missouri's pending proposed demand-side programs and proposed demand-side programs investment mechanism filing. Before ruling on Staff's motion, the Commission will establish a date for the filing of responses to that motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri shall respond to Staff's Motion for Variance Determinations no later than February 24, 2012.
2. Any other party that wishes to respond to Staff's Motion for Variance Determinations shall do so no later than February 24, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
