**ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO AMEREN MISSOURI’S
MOTION TO REVISE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On November 20, 2014, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a motion asking the Commission to revise the established procedural schedule. The current schedule requires the parties to file surrebuttal testimony on November 26 and to file an issues list and proposed order of witnesses and cross-examination by December 15. Ameren Missouri asks that the date to file surrebuttal testimony be extended to December 11, and that the date to file an issues list be extended to December 17. Ameren Missouri does not propose to change the hearing dates from the current schedule. Ameren Missouri also asks for expedited consideration of its motion.

Because the parties must know whether they will be required to file surrebuttal testimony by November 26 in time for them to do so, the Commission will need to rule on Ameren Missouri’s motion promptly. The Commission will shorten the time allowed for responding to Ameren Missouri’s motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Ameren Missouri’s Motion to Revise Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment shall do so no later than November 21, 2014, at 1:00 p.m.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
