2. The hearing shall begin at 9:00 a.m. on July 18, 2024, and shall be held at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 3. The parties shall comply with the following procedural requirements:
 - a. For written testimony, all parties must comply with the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.130 for prepared testimony, including the requirement that testimony be filed on line-numbered pages.
 - b. Although not all parties may agree upon how each issue should be described or on whether a listed issue is in fact a proper issue in this case, the parties shall agree upon and file a list of the issues to be heard, the witnesses to appear on each day of the hearing, the order in which they will be called, and the order of cross-examination for each witness. The Commission will view any issue not contained in this list of issues as not requiring resolution by the Commission.
 - c. All pleadings, briefs, and amendments shall be filed in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.080.
 - d. If part of the testimony or documents are prefiled and served upon the parties before a hearing, a party need only provide a copy of the testimony

or document to the court reporter to be marked as an exhibit at the hearing. If not prefiled and served upon the parties, then a party who has a document marked for use at the hearing shall have sufficient copies of the document to provide a copy not only to the court reporter, but also to each Commissioner, the presiding officer, and counsel for each other party.
