ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

On April 9, 2012, Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) its 2012 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), which is required by the Commission’s Electric Utility Resource Planning rule, 4 CSR 240-22. On September 6, 2012, the Staff of the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources, the Sierra Club, and the Natural Resources Defense Council submitted reports identifying concerns and deficiencies regarding the IRP.

On November 2, 2012, KCP&L requested an extension of time to make additional filings required under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(9) & (10), which are due by November 5, 2012. KCP&L states that it has good cause for the request because the parties are working on a joint agreement to remedy any identified deficiencies and concerns, but need additional time to resolve those issues. KCP&L also represents that no other party opposes the requested two-week extension of time. The Commission finds the request reasonable and will extend the deadline for KCP&L to make additional filings required under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(9) & (10).

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company's *Motion to Extend Time Periods* is granted. Kansas City Power & Light Company shall make additional filings required under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-22.080(9) & (10) no later than November 19, 2012.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
