## ORDER GRANTING STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STAFF'S REPORT

On April 13, 2012, Nickie Hertzog filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that her electric supplier be changed from Osage Valley Electric Cooperative ("Osage Valley") to Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L").<sup>1</sup> The Commission made Osage Valley a party, and required Osage Valley to respond no later than May 16.

On May 14, Osage Valley filed a Request for Extension. Osage Valley explains that Ms. Hertzog has yet to respond to its discovery requests, and, thus, it cannot respond by May 16. Osage Valley asked the Commission to allow it ten days after Ms. Hertzog responds to its discovery requests to respond to the Commission. The Commission granted that request.

On May 23, the Staff of the Commission filed a similar request. Staff explains that it cannot make an informed recommendation until it reviews Osage Valley's response. Thus, Staff asks the Commission to extend its deadline to respond to July 30.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

- 2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than July 30, 2012.
