## NOTICE

COMES NOW, The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) and submits this Notice of Compliance Tariff filings related to 4 CSR 240-20.065.

- The Commission recently revised its net metering rules,
  4 CSR 240-20.065, and those revised rules became effective August 30, 2012.
- 2. The electric utilities were given advance notice of the effective date of this rule and therefore knew that compliance tariffs needed to be filed with the Commission to incorporate the various provisions of the revised rule.
- 3. On September 17, 2012, because multiple electric utilities still had not filed the required compliance tariffs, the Staff Counsel's Office provided additional email notice to each of those electric utilities.
- 4. In its email notice, Staff Counsel advised the electric utilities that, on September 30, 2012, Staff would file a notice with the Commission listing all electric utilities that have not yet complied with 4 CSR 240-20.065 or sought a waiver.
- 5. This Notice will serve to inform the Commission that as of October 1, 2012, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company have not filed compliance tariffs reflecting requirements of the revised rule.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff submits this Notice and seeks direction from the Commission as to whether complaints should be filed.
