ORDER DISMISSING COMPLAINT

Issue Date: March 5, 2024

Effective Date: March 5, 2024

On October 30, 2023, Brett Felber and Lisa Lambert (collectively Complainants) filed a complaint against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri.

On December 15, 2023, a filing purporting to be from Complainants was made which stated they wished to “file their motion to dismiss their complaint against Ameren Missouri.” Because the filing had only the typed names of the Complainants and contained no signatures or other verification that both Complainants wished to dismiss the complaint, the Commission issued an order on December 15, 2023, giving Complainants until December 26, 2023, to file a responsive pleading stating that they wished to continue to pursue their complaint. Complainants have not responded to that order.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 4240-2.116(1) states the following:

An applicant or complainant may voluntarily dismiss an application or complaint without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the commission. Once evidence has been offered or prepared testimony filed, an applicant or complainant may dismiss an action only by leave of the commission, or by written consent of all the parties.

No testimony has been filed and no oral evidence has been offered in this case. No parties have filed an objection to Complainants' motion to dismiss their complaint. The Commission will grant the motion and close the file.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Complainants' motion to dismiss their complaint against Ameren Missouri is granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
3. This file shall close on March 6, 2024.
