- 4. The City has stated that, to the best of its knowledge and based on the professional opinions of its engineering and construction contractors, that the City master metering and pipeline facilities are in full compliance with any and all applicable state and local regulations.

5. The City requests the Commission grant the City's Motion herein, and permit the City to contact PHMSA to provide factual information and documentation that would assist PHMSA in its determination.

WHEREFORE, the City prays the Commission will accept this Motion and provide the relief requested herein, and such other and further relief as is just in the circumstances.
