ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO APPEAR *PRO HAC VICE*

On December 29, 2010, Glenda Cafer, of the Cafer Law Office, L.L.C., filed a motion for admission *pro hac vice* asking leave to appear on behalf of Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (KCP&L-GMO). Ms. Cafer is a member in good standing of the bar of the State of Kansas, and states that she has never been subject to disciplinary proceedings of any kind. She is not admitted to practice in Missouri. The motion designates Roger W. Steiner, corporate counsel for KCPL and KCP&L-GMO and a member of the Missouri bar, as co-counsel. A receipt indicating payment of the fees required by Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) accompanied the motion.

The request for leave to appear complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C), and Missouri Supreme Court Rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. Ms. Cafer will be allowed to appear on behalf of KCPL and KCP&L-GMO.
