On November 23, 2010, at Staff's request, the Commission appointed a Special Master for discovery disputes in ER-2010-0355 and ER-2010-0356 to review documents that were either withheld or redacted in instances where Kansas City Power and Light Company (KCPL") claimed privilege. Since that date, the Special Master has been reviewing documents and conferring with the parties by phone and e-mail. Because of the large number of documents being reviewed at this late stage of the litigation, the Special Master will direct the parties to file a timeline listing all of the dates the specific disputed data requests were issued to KCPL by Staff and the dates when KCPL responded asserting attorney-client and/or work-product privileges.

The data requests that are the subject of the dispute are listed in KCPL's motion for reconsideration filed on November 29, 2010. Additionally, there are some data requests that were listed in paragraphs 7 and 8 of KCPL's November 29 motion that, according to the parties, are no longer in dispute. Those data requests are numbers

422, 424, 337, 348, 427, 439.2, 630.3, 650, 843, 899, 963 and 964. KCPL believes they have fully responded to those requests and that there are no privileged documents to produce. Staff agreed during a phone conference with the parties. The parties shall include the timeline for when these data requests were issued and answered in the timeline for the disputed data requests.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than January 4, 2011, Kansas City Power and Light Company and the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file the timeline described in the body of this order. If the parties cannot agree on the timeline, they shall each file separate timelines.
 - 2. This order shall become effective immediately on issuance.
