On June 4, 2010, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission received an intervention request from the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Unions No. 412, 1464, and 1613.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party responded to this application to intervene. Therefore, the Commission will take up the application unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds that the applicants meet the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the above-mentioned application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The Application to Intervene of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Unions No. 412, 1464, and 1613, is granted.
