ORDER GRANTING EXPANDED DESIGNATION AS AN ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER

Issue Date: March 21, 2024 Effective Date: March 31, 2024

On January 18, 2024, Easy Telephone Service Company d/b/a Easy Wireless filed its application for expansion of its designation as a wireless Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC). Easy Wireless seeks to expand that designation to apply statewide to be able to provide Lifeline service to all eligible low-income households.

The Commission issued notice and set a deadline for intervention. No intervention requests were received.

The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) conducted an investigation and on March 1, 2024, filed its recommendation and memorandum. Staff recommended that the Commission approve Easy Wireless' request for designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of receiving federal low-income

support. Staff stated Easy Wireless met the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-31.016 governing eligible telecommunications carriers. Staff notes that Easy Wireless requests a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017, and recommends that such waiver be granted.

Under federal authority, the application is within the Commission's jurisdiction to decide.² Since no law requires a hearing, this is a non-contested case.³ Non-contested cases do not require formal proceedings or hearings before the Commission.⁴ Consequently, the Commission bases its decision on the verified filings.

Based upon its review of the verified application and Staff's recommendation and memorandum, the Commission finds that Easy Wireless has met the requirements for ETC designation. Further, for good cause shown, Easy Wireless will be granted a waiver of the 60-day filing requirement of the Commission's rules. So that the ETC designation may take effect as soon as possible, the Commission finds it reasonable to make this order effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- Easy Wireless' application is granted. Easy Wireless is granted ETC status for the purpose of receiving statewide federal low-income support.
- 2. Easy Wireless is granted a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017.
 - 3. This order shall become effective on March 31, 2024.
