ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On February 2, 2024, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois (ATXI) filed an application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) pursuant to Section 393.170.1, RSMo. The CCN would authorize ATXI to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control a new 345 kV switchyard and associated facilities (known as "Fabius Switchyard") in Knox County, Missouri.

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of March 6, 2024, for applications to intervene. The Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri filed a timely application to intervene. Renew Missouri's application states that it is "a non-profit policy group whose mission is to transform Missouri into a leading state in renewable energy and energy efficiency."

More than ten days have passed since the application was filed and no one has responded. After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri has an interest which is different from that of the general public and allowing it to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The application to intervene of Renew Missouri is granted.
- 2. This order is effective when issued.
