ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO FILE SUR-SURREBUTTALTESTIMONY AND SETTING TIME FOR RESPONSES AND OBJECTIONS

On March 27, 2024, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its *Motion* to Strike Portions of the Surrebuttal Testimony of Staff Witnesses Claire M. Eubanks and Shawn Lange and of Office of the Public Counsel Witness David Murray, and Alternative Motion for Leave to File Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony, and Motion for Expedited Treatment. Ameren Missouri asks to strike portions of the pre-filed surrebuttal testimony of Staff witnesses Claire Eubanks and Shawn Lange. Ameren Missouri also asks to strike the Office of the Public Counsel's witness David Murray's surrebuttal testimony in its entirety.

In the alternative, Ameren Missouri asks that it be allowed to filed sur-surrebuttal testimony responsive to portions of the testimony that is the subject of Ameren Missouri's motion to strike. Ameren Missouri also requests expedited treatment by April 3, 2024, stating that the hearing in this case will commence 12 days later. However, Ameren Missouri has also filed a motion to take a witness out of order on April 12, 2024, further shortening the number of days until the evidentiary hearing.

Because of the compressed time frame before the evidentiary hearing, the Commission will permit Ameren Missouri to file sur-surrebuttal testimony that is concise and narrowly tailored to respond to the surrebuttal testimony that was the subject of its

motion to strike. The Commission will also set a time for other parties to file responses to the motion to strike, objections to Ameren Missouri's motion to file additional testimony, and any objections to Ameren Missouri' sur-surrebuttal testimony. The Commission will not rule on Ameren Missouri's motion to strike or the admissibility of sur-surrebuttal testimony at this time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Ameren Missouri may file sur-surrebuttal testimony that is concise and narrowly tailored to respond to the surrebuttal testimony that was the subject of its motion to strike no later than April 4, 2024.
- 2. Any responses to Ameren Missouri's motion to strike, objection's to Ameren Missouri's motion to file sur-surrebuttal testimony, or objections to its sur-surrebuttal testimony must be filed no later than April 8, 2024.
 - This order is effective when issued.
